Post- tattoo instructions for patients

Please keep the dressing dry and intact for 3 days. You may notice a few spots of blood on it- this is not of concern. After three days please remove the dressing and apply the ointment you have been given (chloramphenicol) to the tattooed area twice a day till the tube runs out. It should last about a week. Miss Hunter will review the tattoo in clinic in about six weeks. It is common to require a top up tattoo and this will be discussed at this point and booked if desired. Should you have any concerns about how the tattoo is healing in the interim (lots of discharge or redness are signs that perhaps there is an infection for instance) then please call Sophie who can arrange for Miss Hunter to review you earlier.
